THE ISLE OF MAN

AN ISLAND OF HISTORY

The Isle of Man's landscape is dotted with historic attractions including medieval castles, museums, ancient monuments and maritime charms that give you a real taste of the Island's past.

You can find a sense of heritage around almost every corner of the Island, which has one of the most concentrated and best cared for historic landscapes in Europe. Some attractions are spread across the countryside whilst others can be found within easy walking distance of each other in towns and villages throughout the Island, all of which are accessible via rail or bus.

The Manx Museum, situated in the Island's capital Douglas, is a key destination for any visit to the Isle of Man. The museum includes a series of modern state of the art galleries which reveal the unique story of the Island through films, exhibitions and interactive displays.

The Island's heritage sites can be visited by road, foot, railways and Horse Tram. The Isle of Man Steam Railway and Manx Electric Railway stations are only a short walk from the Manx Museum.

Opened in 1874, the Isle of Man Steam Railway still runs with its original locomotives and carriages, through an ever changing landscape, to a choice of destinations in the south. At Ballasalla, enjoy the ancient Cistercian monastery of Rushen Abbey, which includes beautiful gardens and a modern interpretive centre, complemented by the Abbey Restaurant.

You can continue your journey by Steam Railway to Castletown where there are four further historic sites to visit, including Castle Rushen, one of the world's most finely preserved medieval castles.

Not far from the Castle is the Old House of Keys, the fascinating former home to Tynwald, the Manx Parliament, where you can take a seat in the finely restored debating chamber, watch as interactive portraits come to life and take part in some great debates. Nearby the Old Grammar School is also well worth a visit; along with the Nautical Museum with its maritime charms.



Further south, the National Folk Museum at Cregneash is an absolute must see and accessible by foot, car or bus. Here, you can see traditional thatched cottages and farm buildings which illustrate a traditional Manx way of life at the end of the 19th century. While at Cregneash, during the summer season enjoy the daily demonstrations including traditional cooking, spinning, and needlecraft and sample traditional Manx dishes in the Village Tea Rooms.

The Sound Restaurant and Visitor Centre is also situated nearby and offers spectacular panoramic views of Manx coastal scenery and the Calf of Man.

In the West of the Island, you can enjoy a visit to the House of Manannan in Peel where you are greeted by the Island's mythological sea god Manannan,

who welcomes you to his fascinating Kingdom and guides you through the Island's rich Celtic, Viking and maritime past.

While in Peel, walk along the stunning marina and quayside to Peel Castle, an ancient fortress situated on St Patrick's Isle and overlooking Peel harbour.

After visiting Peel, travel south to Niarbyl, where you can enjoy the café and visitor centre, and discover the traditional thatched cottages at Niarbyl Bay

In the north of the Island, visit the Grove Museum of Victorian Life in Ramsey, along with its delightful tearooms. Beautifully preserved, a visit to the house, outbuildings and country garden is like stepping back in time.

From Ramsey or Douglas, enjoy a trip on the Manx Electric Railway to Laxey where you can see The Great Laxey Wheel, one of the Island's most iconic sites and the largest surviving working water wheel in the world. The impressive 22m (72.5 feet) diameter water wheel was built in 1854 and has remained one of the Isle of Man's most dramatic tourist attractions for over 150 years.

NORTH BY ELECTRIC



Step aboard your tram car at the Manx Electric Railway terminus at Douglas (known as Derby Castle) situated at the northern end of Douglas promenade.

Sit back and relax as the spectacular Manx countryside passes slowly by.

The Manx Electric Railway hugs the Island's east coast as you pass through leaf filled glens, gorse topped hills and spectacular coastal scenery as it winds its way northwards towards Laxey and Ramsey. Laxey is the starting point for the Snaefell Mountain Railway, a unique Victorian enterprise which winds its way up above 2,000 feet to the top of Snaefell, the Island's only mountain. At the top enjoy the breathtaking views; it is the only place in the British Isles where you can see England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales just by turning around. While at the top, enjoy refreshments in the Summit Hotel café.

Laxey is also home to the Lady Isabella, the world's largest water wheel, and the mines trail, which gives a glimpse into Laxey's fascinating subterranean past.

SOUTH BY STEAM



Opened in 1874, this narrow gauge railway still runs with its original locomotives and carriages, through an ever changing landscape, to a choice of destinations in the south of the Island.

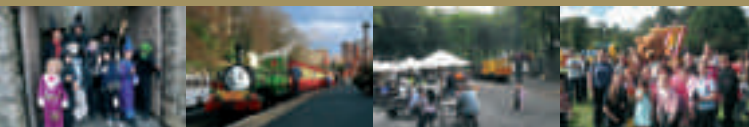
At Ballasalla there is the ancient Cistercian monastery of Rushen Abbey, restored in 2000 with a modern interpretive centre explaining this historic monastic treasure.

Enjoy a leisurely stroll along the river to Silverdale Glen with its café, boating lake and children's play area. In Castletown there are four unique heritage sites continuing The Story of Mann theme, Castle Rushen, the Nautical Museum, The Old Grammar School and the Old House of Keys. Nearby there are shops, pubs and restaurants to visit.

The final two destinations are Port St Mary with its busy sheltered harbour, sandy beaches, 9 hole golf course and café or spend the day in Port Erin, which is always a favourite for families, with its soft sandy beach.

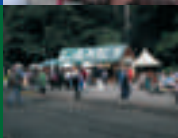
The Whistle Stop Café is situated within the Port Erin Railway Station Building and is open throughout the year.



Inside Douglas Railway Station we have The Tickethall, a new Restaurant for 2011, serving a range of vegetarian and pescetarian meals, homemade cakes and refreshments.



Laxey Station Café is sited within the Manx Electric Railway Station building, a short way from the Rose Gardens in the centre of the Village. The Café provides light snacks, homemade cakes and is open throughout the Snaefell operating season.



At the top of the Island the Snaefell Summit Hotel, is open during the Snaefell Railways operating season. The Hotel provides a range of hot and cold food and boasts superb views across the whole Island. On a clear day you can view the Seven Kingdoms of Mann, England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales, Heaven and the Kingdom of the Sea.



The Summit Hotel is also the location for our popular Snaefell Sunset Dinners, available from June 15th to September 9th; as well as offering a great Sunday lunch.

Railway Museum Built right next door to the Port Erin Railway Station and first opened in 1975, the museum is situated in part of the old train storage shed and holds excellently refurbished steam trains and carriages. A section of the building is still used for the continued maintenance of the trains running on the line. It is even possible to look through a set of windows into the blacksmith's workshop.

OTHER RAILWAYS OF THE ISLE OF MAN

Douglas Corporation Horse Trams

(Island Explorer Tickets are valid for travel)

Opened in 1876 this horse drawn tramway operates along the seafront in Douglas, between the Sea Terminal and Derby Castle, still using its original rolling stock. An ideal and interesting way to travel between the Isle of Man Steam and Manx Electric Railways. The Horse Trams operate during the summer season.

Orchid Line

(Island Explorer Tickets not valid for travel)

A miniature railway at the Curraghs Wildlife Park operates on Sundays from Easter to October and on some Saturdays in peak season. A wide variety of locomotives can be seen working on the line.

The Great Laxey Mines Railway

(Island Explorer Tickets not valid for travel)

The Great Laxey Mine Railway runs over the surface section of the former mine tramway which once brought thousands of tons of lead ore from deep within the famed Great Laxey Mine.

Using replicas of the two original steam locomotives "Ant" and "Bee", trains travel through the longest railway tunnel on the Island. The line commences in the Valley Gardens just a short walk from Laxey tram station.

The railway operates every Saturday from 23rd April until Saturday 24th September 2011, every Sunday during August 2011 and on the following Bank Holidays and Special Event Days:-

Easter Sunday **24th April** (Great Laxey and Lonan Duck Race), Easter Monday **25th April**, Bank Holiday Monday **2nd May**, Bank Holiday Monday **30th May**, Tuesday **5th July** (Tynwald Fair Day), Sat **30th July** & Sun **31st July** (Heritage Transport Festival), Bank Holiday Monday **29th August**, Sun **23rd**, Sat **29th** & Sun **30th October** (Hop Tu Naa Ghost Trains. 12 noon until 6.30pm.).

Trains run every few minutes from 11.00am until 4.30pm

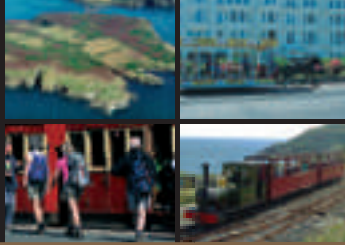
