

Bus Departures from Douglas During Highway Works in Lord Street

Phase A

Commencing from all departures after 0815 on Wednesday 14th July, 2010, due to the resurfacing works a number of bus services will not be able to depart from the shelters in Lord Street and will depart from the points as detailed below.

Services 1 & 2	All services will depart from Shelter E.
Service X1	The 1708 journey will commence at the Town Hall stop in Ridgeway Street.
Service X2	The 0925, 1150 & 1450 journeys will commence at the stop opposite the Salvation Army in Lord Street.
Service X3	The 0950 & 1250 journeys will pick up at the Town Hall stop in Ridgeway Street.
Services 4, 4A, 4B, 9X & 14	The 0800 Service 4 and all journeys on Services 4A, 4B, 9X & 14 will commence at the stop opposite the Salvation Army in Lord Street.
Services 4, 5, 5A and 6	The 1040 & 1125 Service 4 journeys and all journeys on Services 5, 5A & 6 will depart from Shelter E .
Service X5	The 1708 journey will commence at the Town Hall stop in Ridgeway Street.
Services 9A, 9B, 9C & 11A	All journeys will commence at the Town Hall stop in Ridgeway Street.
Service 11	All journeys will commence at the stop opposite the Salvation Army in Lord Street.
Services 13 and 13A	All journeys will depart from Shelter E .
Service 21	All journeys will depart from Shelter D .
Service 22	All journeys will commence at the Town Hall stop in Ridgeway Street.
Service 23	All journeys will commence at the Town Hall stop in Ridgeway Street.
Service 25	All journeys will commence at the Town Hall stop in Ridgeway Street.
Service 25A	All journeys will commence at the Town Hall stop in Ridgeway Street.
Service 29	The 1400 & 1630 journeys will commence at the stop opposite the Salvation Army in Lord Street.
Douglas arrivals	Buses arriving in Douglas will not be able to set down in Lord Street. Passengers are advised to alight at either the Victoria Street or "bottleneck" bus stops. Passengers continuing past these stops may be set down in Parade Street (beside the 'steam packet' car park) or at the stop opposite the Salvation Army in Lord Street.
